WFP with the support of local authorities and implementing partner People In Need introduced Food for Assets projects which focus on rebuilding assets, and livelihoods. Since March 2016 enthusiasm within the local community of Amvrosievka (Donetsk GCA) has seen an increase from 9 to 43 people involved. Almost 100 people in Blagodatnoe (Donetsk GCA) worked on creation of a road to bypass a bridge destroyed in the fighting.
