UN Human Rights Monitoring Mission presented the 13th human rights situation report

UN HRMMU report exposed the indiscriminate shelling, the presence of anti-personnel mines and remnants of war in the eastern Ukraine. Report says between 16 Nov 2015 and 15 Feb 2016,

78 conflict-related civilian casualties were recorded, bringing the estimated casualty figures to more than 30,000 people, including at least 9,160 killed and 21,000 injured in the East.

UNDP with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Denmark launched Enhanced Public Sector Transparency and Integrity Project



The objectives of the project for 2015-2018 are to review the existing impediments towards the fully-functioning National Agency for Prevention of Corruption (NAPC) and to ensure the development of e-asset declarations verification system. With its launch, approximately 500-700,000 public officials will have a 'one stop shop' electronic facility open 24/7.

UN Women, UN Ukraine and civil society called to step up efforts for gender equality in Ukraine on the International Women`s Day



At the press conference "Planet 50-50 by 2030" UN and civil society reported that women and girls face daily discrimination in political, economic and social sphere. Revealed data show that among the members of the Parliament of Ukraine, 12% are women, and in the Cabinet of Ministers – 11%. The difference in wages between women and men is 23.7%.
